Advisory Council Meeting 2007-2008 2nd Quarter Meeting Minutes Friday, January 18, 2008

Members attending: Earl McKinley, Kerry Symons, Diane Thorpe, and Barry Willis, and Lew Hunnicutt

Before conducting business, Hunnicutt announced that Jack and Rita Allen had established two FPC nursing scholarships of \$2500 each. The Council expressed appreciation for the generous contribution.

The Council considered old business, discussing the workforce program survey. The surveys were dispersed around town as well as via e-mail, yet none were returned. Hunnicutt will visit with participants in other FPC programs and activities in an attempt to gather information about needed workforce programs. In other old business, Hunnicutt announced that five spaces remain in the Square Foot Program. Hunnicutt also reported that three roof leaks, one being a new leak, appeared after a recent snow. The roof is still under warranty. Final old business concerned technology on the Allen campus. Every classroom on the entire campus is now a “smart” room.

In new business, it was announced that the Texas Archeological Society will convene in the Wolf Creek area June 14-21. The group will utilize Allen campus facilities for displays, for continuing education, and for other group activities. Hunnicutt then presented recent statistics relevant to FPC enrollment both in Borger and in Perryton. Finally, the Council adjourned before touring the greenhouse. Several new hydroponic projects were displayed by Bobette Doerrie, who also explained other future plans for the greenhouse area.
