CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT POLICY

A student whose high school class has not been graduated and is pursuing his/her high school diploma may be enrolled on a concurrent basis under the following conditions:

- (1) A student must agree that credit for courses taken at Frank Phillips College will be awarded at the completion of coursework.
- (2) A student may take courses concurrently provided he/she satisfies entry requirements for the college course.
- (3) The student must meet all the admission requirements as listed in the Frank Phillips College catalog.
- (4) ...Beginning with the fall 1998 semester, each undergraduate student, ***unless otherwise exempt***, who enters a public institution of higher learning ***must*** be tested for reading, writing, and mathematical skills ***prior to enrolling in any collegiate-level coursework***...(Section 5.313, Subchapter P, TEC 51.306 and 51.403)
