### 2010-2011 Advisory Council 3rd Quarter Meeting Minutes Wednesday, April 20, 2011

#### **Old Business:**

The architecture/construction firm will meet with Dr. Hunnicutt and the contractor of the Frank Phillips College-Allen Campus building on May 5<sup>th</sup> to discuss the possible solutions to the problems with the building.

State funding for Community Colleges and the benefits package are included in the latest state budget; however, the benefits package cost will come from the state funding for the colleges.

#### **New Business:**

Dr. Hunnicutt was pleased to report that the new Frank Phillips College President is Dr. Jud Hicks who had been serving as the interim President since December.

The 2010-2011 Allen Campus budget status was presented to the board; Dr. Hunnicutt reported that 56% of the budget has been spent after 7 months of the budget year.

Dr. Hunnicutt illustrated for the board the service area for Frank Phillips College. The service area covers 9,392 square miles in nine upper Panhandle counties. Dr. Hunnicutt reported that he recently visited the city of Dalhart to encourage the use of Frank Phillips College in that area. Meeting attendees asked about having a campus in Dalhart at some point in the future. Hunnicutt told them that the college is open to all ideas.

The college is extremely proud that Kerry Symons will be the Graduation 2011 speaker on May 6, 2011.

The new FPC volleyball coach and math instructor for Frank Phillips is Ashley Dyer of Perryton.

Dr. Hunnicutt showed the board the new form that is being used to better illustrate the number of people served by the Frank Phillips system. Previously, the state received only the reportable number of students which did not truly reflect the number of people served at each of the campuses. Reportable individuals are those students for which the state provides funding.

The Scholarship Vision Banquet is scheduled for April 28, 2011. Final plans for that banquet were discussed.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
