Abbreviation Legend

Dept./Course#: Identifies the course and corresponds with The Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS), ACGM or WECM.

Course Name: Name of the course.

Course Type: Identifies the type of class and how it is delivered. See Course Types below.

Section Number: The course section number is a code used to identify a particular class.

Session: The session identifies the length of the term "MAIN" or "MINI".

Time: The time column lists the meeting times of the class; U (TBA) 0:00 denotes "to be arranged with the instructor".

Instructor: Instructors are listed by their last name, and the term "staff" denotes an instructor has not yet been assigned.

Bldg. & Room: The building and room abbreviations are listed below. Room numbers are posted above the door of each room.

Lec	Face-to-face instruction in the classroom at a specified day and time
Lab	Lab time required for a course at a specified day and time
L/L	Face-to-face instruction in classroom with individually arranged lab time
Inet	Coursework is designed specifically for online (Internet) and uses a student access portal for assignments, chats, and tests
InetL	Coursework is designed specifically for online (Internet) and uses a student access portal for assignments, chats, tests, and lab
LecHy	Hybrid class meets one day a week and the second class period is required coursework online in Student Portal
L/LHy	Hybrid class meets one day a week and the second class period is required coursework online in Student Portal and TBA lab time
DLR	FPC lecture is delivered via Distance Learning Technology to off-campus sites with live interactivity
DLR/L	Lab time is required at the FPC main campus in addition to the DLR (distance learning) lecture
